## Design a tiger territory

Design a tiger enclosure in the space below. You should include everything a tiger needs to be happy and healthy such as:

- Boomer ball.
- Door.
- Windows.
- Meat.
- Long grass.
- Tree.
- Pond.
- Sleeping place.
- Safety fence.
- Feeding pole.



### Tigers need:

- Shelter outdoors, from all types of weather (sun, wind, rain, etc).
- A warm bed indoors (provide an indoor den as well as a shelter outside).
- Trees to give shade.
- Long grass to hide in.
- A pond with fresh water.
- Toys to play with for enrichment, like balls, herbs and sacks.
- A feeding pole (to put the meat up high, so that the tigers have to jump and climb to get at it) and some meat.
- A door for keepers to get in to clean and provide food.
- Lots of windows for the visitors to look through.
- Safety barriers to keep the tigers safely inside and people safely outside the enclosure.
- Think about the size of the enclosure, add a scale and draw in your tigers. Only two tigers can live together at a time, a male and a female.
