





- When the Leader lowers their arms, get your Six to squat down and call out 'Akela, we'll do our best'.
- When the Leader shouts out 'Cubs, do your best' make sure your Six salutes and shouts back 'We will do our best!'.

Help the leaders

As a Sixer, you can help your leaders in lots of ways; here are some of the things you can do:

- Get your Six ready for the meeting.
- Help explain games to new Cubs.
- Run a game for the whole Pack.
- Get equipment ready for activities and tidy them away after.

- Be a good role model for the younger Cubs.
- Make the most out of everything you do.

Be kind to new Cubs on Pack night and camp
