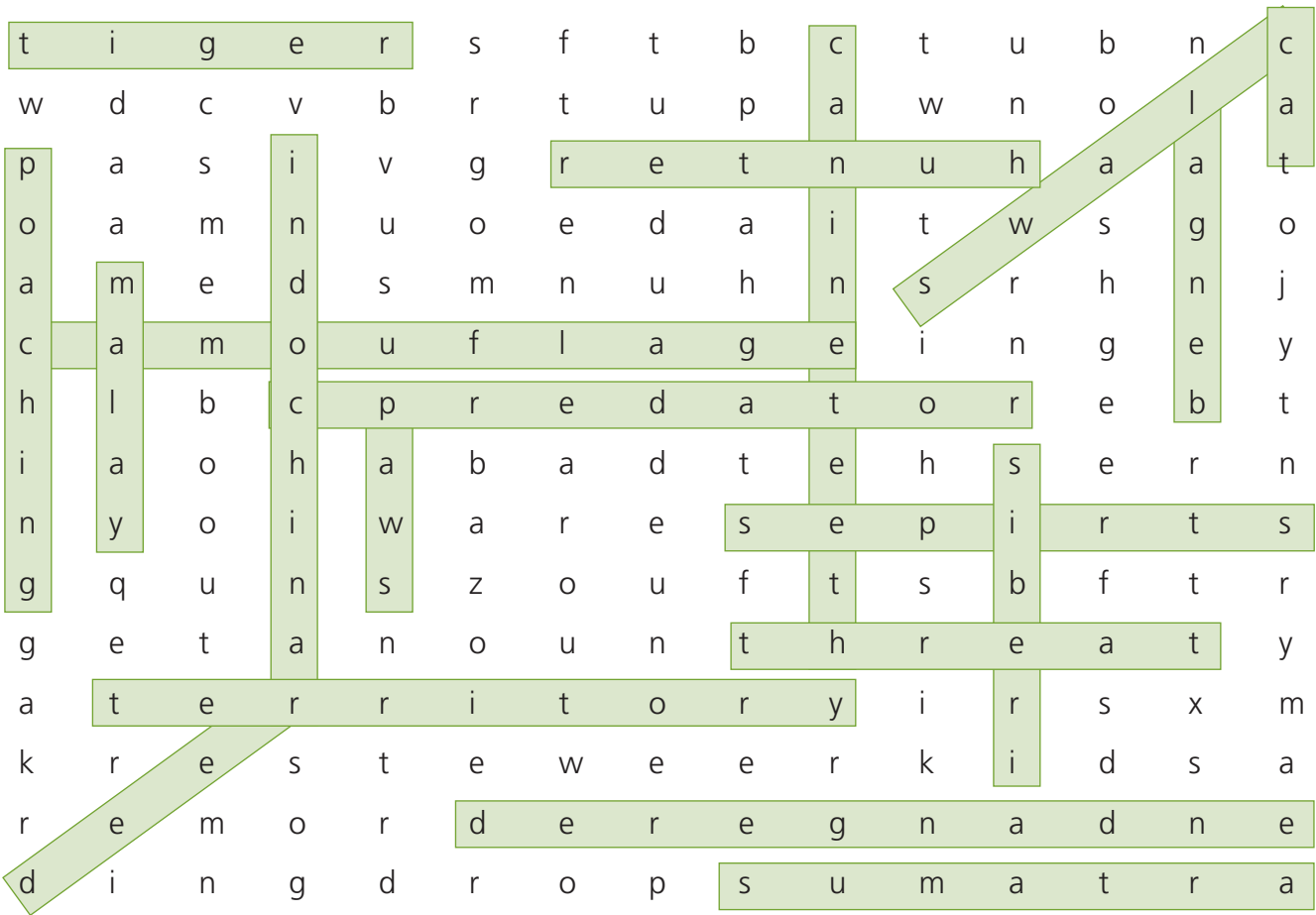

| 1 | A tiger's main diet consists of leaves and fruit. | False | Tigers are carnivores and their main diet consists of meat. |
| 2 | A tiger has stripes to scare away other animals. | False | Tiger stripes help them to be camouflaged when hunting their prey. |
| 3 | A tiger has four canine teeth. | True | Tigers have two at the top and two at the bottom, working together to rip and slice meat. |
| 4 | Tigers can see in the dark. | True | A tiger's eyes are yellow and amber. They have a reflective layer at the back of the eye which gives them excellent night vision. |
| 5 | A tiger can live for over 30 years. | False | A tiger rarely lives for more than 20 years in captivity and much less in the wild. |
| 6 | A baby tiger is called a pup. | False | A baby tiger is called a cub. |
| 7 | In zoos, tigers are usually kept together in pairs. | True | They do live in pairs so that they can breed. |
| 8 | A group of tigers is called a pride. | False | Tigers tend to live alone or with their cubs. They don't hunt in groups. |
| 9 | There are only 300 Sumatran tigers left in the wild. | True | ZSL estimates that there are around 300 left. |
| 10 | Tigers live in Africa in the wild. | False | Tigers live in Asia. |
| 11 | There are five different types (sub-species) of tiger. | True | The sub species include the Bengal, Sumatran, Indo-Chinese, Siberian and Malayan tiger. |
| 12 | Poachers kill tigers for their bones, skin and teeth. | True | Tiger bones skin or teeth are sold illegally to be used in traditional medicines or for other reasons. |
