



## **National Board of Trustees Update: Saturday 15 July 2017**

At its meeting on 15 July, the Board undertook a comprehensive training session on Health and Safety. The Board also dealt with a wide range of matters, including the approval of the Association's Annual Report and Accounts 2016/17. The key topics presented to the Board included:

- Approval of the Membership Subscription Fee for 2018/19, which sees an increase of 50p
- The Chair of the Board of Trustees, UK Chief Commissioner, UK Youth Commissioner and Chief Executive reported against their annual objectives
- Amendments to the Scouts Scotland Constitution
- An update on The Association's digital work area
