WHAT CAN WE DO?

- Would you like to make a difference locally or try tackling something on a national or international scale?
- How are you going to collect money?
- Will you primarily deal with cash or are you going to try an online donation website?
- How will you raise awareness of your challenge? Social media is brilliant, but so is word of mouth!

WHAT'S YOUR CHALLENGE?

Ready to get started? Here are some ideas.

Challenge ideas

- raise £100
- collectively run or swim 100km (a team ultramarathon!)
- sell 100 cupcakes / slices of cake / mugs of tea
- make and sell 100 woggles
- collect and donate 100 items to a foodbank
- sell 100 items at a jumble sale
- fundraise enough to buy 100 mosquito nets
- find out how much money you can raise in 100 hours / minutes
- organise a charity ball for 100 people
